The Innovation cell under the ministry of education, government of India has certified Neerja Modi School for establishment school innovation council. Crest EduFund Olympiads has awarded NMS with the best school award 2023-24.

The University of Sydney has awarded NMS with the Climate Change Champion Award 2023.

Our commitment to academic excellence remains unwavering. I am delighted to share that our students have once again excelled in various examinations, securing top ranks and distinctions. Our dedicated faculty right from kindergarten to grade XII deserves special recognition for their tireless efforts in imparting knowledge, character building and fostering love for learning among our students. I am honoured to highlight the remarkable achievements of our students.

In the CBSE grade X Examination - 3 students scored 99% and above, 11 students secured 98% and above, 57 students secured aggregate 95% and above, 135 students scored 90% and above and 284 students scored overall distinction.

In grade XII CBSE examination -32 students secured aggregate 95% and above, 101 students scored 90% and above and 252 scored overall distinction.

In grade 10 IGCSE examination 66% of the class scored A\*and A Grade in **various** subjects. 3 students Aditya Agarwal, Yajvin Singhal and Prisha Jain scored 10 A\* in all their 10 subjects while 3 students Charvi Bansal, Pratyush Singhal and Anshita Goyal scored 9 A\*s.

In the IBDP examination 2023, 24% of the class scored 40 and above IB Points. Our school average was 35.5 points against the world average of 30.24 IB Points.
