VII. ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED IN SCHOOL

Inter-house Activities: A dynamic platform for healthy competition and collaborative learning was formed through these activities.

- **Rangoli Making** Competition for Grades 7 and above showcased remarkable artistic finesse through intricate designs and vibrant colour combinations, reflecting creativity and coordinated teamwork.
- **Music competitions**, including Western Duet (vocal with instrumental accompaniment) and Indian Vocal Solo, presented a harmonious blend of classical traditions and contemporary styles.
- **Inter-house Dance Competition** captivated audiences with expressive choreography and thematic presentations.
- An intellectually stimulating **Debate Competition** for Grades 6 to 9 enabled participants to demonstrate strong research skills, critical thinking, and articulate public speaking abilities.

Young Student Parliament: One of the most enriching initiatives of the session was the Young Student Parliament, which provided students with practical insights into parliamentary functioning through structured debates and role-play. Participants experienced the processes of discussion, questioning, law-making, and decision-making, fostering leadership qualities, democratic values, civic awareness, and respect for diverse perspectives.

Students actively participated in *Pariksha Pe Charcha*, gaining valuable guidance on stress management, effective study strategies, and maintaining a positive approach towards examinations.

Participation in various **National and International Olympiads** further reinforced the school's commitment to academic excellence by enhancing conceptual clarity and analytical thinking.

Visits: Learning beyond the classroom remained a key focus throughout the year. Students from Pre-Primary to Grade 4 visited Swad Ri Dhani, where they experienced the rich cultural heritage of Rajasthan through exposure to traditional art, craft, and cuisine. Students of Grade 5 and above visited an adventure park in Pushkar, participating enthusiastically in activities such as zorbing, archery, army obstacle courses, ziplining, and target shooting. These excursions fostered teamwork, courage, resilience, physical fitness, and confidence.

Annual Sports Day was celebrated with great enthusiasm and sporting spirit. Track and field events, drills, and house-wise competitions showcased students' athletic abilities while reinforcing discipline, perseverance, and teamwork.

Self Defence: A special self-defense training camp was organized for girls from Grade I to IX, empowering them with essential safety skills and confidence.

Health Check Up: In keeping with the belief in “a healthy mind in a healthy body,” a comprehensive health check-up camp was conducted for all students. A team of four doctors: Dr Mayur Goyal -Child Specialist, Dr Nikita Sharma- Pedodontist, Dt Gauri Mehra-Dietician and Dr. Rinny Khanna for provided their services. Parents of Pre-Primary students participated actively, and health-related queries were addressed.

The school organized year-long commemorative activities on “**Vande Mataram**”, fostering patriotism and national pride among students.
