COOKERY CLUB

Recipe: Papdi Chaat

MATERIAL REQUIRED:

- papdi: 8-10 pieces
- boiled kala chana: 1 tablespoon
- chopped onion: 1 tablespoon
- boiled potatoes (cut): 1 tablespoon
- zero number sev – 2 tablespoons
- mint chutney – 2 tablespoons
- imli chutney – 2 tablespoon
- curd – 1 cup
- chaat masala -2 teaspoon
- roasted cumin powder – 2 teaspoons
- rock salt- 1 teaspoon
- salt – according to taste
- pomegranate – 2 tablespoons (optional)



Note: Please bring an apron, table mat, one plate, a big service spoon, 2-3 disposable spoons and tissue paper
